

IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED AT POLLS (F.S. 101.043)

The clerk or inspector shall require you, upon entering the polling place, to present one of the following current and valid picture identifications:

| ✓ Public Assistance I.D. | ✓ Employee ID card issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the Federal Government, the state, a county, or municipality. |

If the picture identification does not have your signature, an additional identification that provides your signature shall be required. If you are unable to furnish the required identification, you shall be allowed to vote a provisional ballot. The canvassing board shall determine the validity of the ballot.

If you have moved from the address shown, contact the Supervisor of Elections office at 850-784-6100 immediately to determine your new voting location. You can also visit our website at www.bayvotes.org

No person shall be permitted to vote in any election precinct or district other than the one in which the person has his or her legal residence and in which the person is registered (F.S. 101.045). You will be required to confirm your current address at voter check-in.
